

We are not short of open data in climate science


- 16 different comprehensive historical rainfall datasets covering Africa

- Primary observations are typically not open




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
The challenge is that data is not information and people are looking for information








CRU rainfall trends Cape Town



























- Are we responsible for how the data we make available is used?
